Extrajudicial killings - reported or suspected	1,083
Extrajudicial killings - in exit attempts	156
Attack on civilians outside of Cuba (terrorism)	22
Forced disappearances	49
Other disappearances (most in exit attempts)	1,140
Medical negligence/denial of medical care (in detention)	441
Hunger strikes	21
Suicides: induced or alleged (most in prison)	175
Exit attempts: drowning, dehydration, mines, etc.	202
Other deaths: accidents, in prison, etc.	313
Combat fatalities or Missing in action	<u>887</u>
<b>Sub-total</b>	<b>7,537</b>

**Actions against the Cuban State**

Politically-motivated by non-state actors (not in combat)	35
Combat – insurrection, Bay of Pigs invasion	156
Combat - by armed forces of other countries, incl. Cubans in Angola, Ethiopia, Congo, etc.	548
Killed by accidents/illnesses in Angola, Ethiopia, etc.	<u>288</u>
<b>Sub-total</b>	<b>1,127</b>
