Enrique García, former officer of Cuba's Intelligence Division and two other former Cuban intelligence officers who remain anonymous.

Notes

Each officer of the Directorate of Intelligence manages up to 15 intel. relationships, each military intel. officer up to 20; only 13 were used for this estimate.

On average, 60% of intelligence relationships are agents, the rest are "relations of influence" or "useful liaisons."

*Illegals Department

Each officer of the Illegals Dept. (2 per 6 original provinces) recruits and trains 6 illegals a year = 72.

Training of illegals began in 1962, this estimate is for 56 years (1964-2020). It assumes that 50% of 72 recruits completed the training and 60% were assigned to the U.S. (Approximately 40% of illegals go to other countries.)
