Notes

Each officer of the DI manages up to 15 intel. relationships, and each military intel. officer manages up to 20 relationships. An average of 13 was used for this conservative estimate.

***Illegals Department**

Around 72 "illegal" officers are recruited annually and 50% were estimated to have completed the training and assigned, 60% to the U.S. over 59 years (1965-2024).
